- 2. Legislative Update from Laura:
 - a) > HB 1012 Expansion of PDMP to include information regarding all prescription drugs prescribed in Colorado. CAPPN board did not support. It is very popular with committee.
 - b) Health Care Bill: This is an effort to control costs and push insurers to decrease costs by 20% over 2 year period.
- 3. Program 3: Dana Murphy Parker will present on stigma and care disparities in substance use disorders on April 27th at 6:30pm. Marlene states she is able to handle the technical logistics with back up from Jordan.

- 4. There is a proposal by City Council to limit access of tobacco flavored products in Denver to decrease the impact on adolescents. The Board supports this effort. Kaiser nurses are in support. NPAC can endorse local issues, but GAAP usually addresses state level concerns. Ruby will send letter to Katherine. Marlene will send logo/letterhead to Katherine to forward to Kaiser and City Council.
- 5. Treasurer Report: Laura reported that the current balance is near \$10,452. We are probably still receiving funds for non-CAPPN members.

- 6. Annual dues will be due in July, \$40 for members and \$25 for students. Will be waived this year. Discussed purging mail list of non-members vs leaving as is. Mailing list and Education open to all nurses with interest. Discussed meaning of being a CAPPN member.
- 7. Ronnie would like to have a discussion on the agenda in the future to discuss confidentiality with clinical presentations.
