- She graduated from St. Luke's Hospital School of Nursing in 1959 and received a BSN from the University of Denver in 1960
 - In the hospital setting, she progressed from medical-surgical night nurse to staff development to director of nursing service
- She joined CNA in the 1970s and became executive director in 1980
- She was executive director of Association of periOperative Registered Nurses, or AORN, in 1990, returning to CNA as interim executive director in 2000
 - She was treasurer of CNA and later treasurer of the American Nurses Association
- She served as president of the CU School of Nursing Alumni Association and as executive director of the New York State Nurses Association
 - She has demonstrated outstanding leadership with voluntary organizations
