- Dorothy “Dort” Gregg began her career in psychiatric nursing in 1947 at the State Hospital in Pueblo
- After obtaining her Master’s at Columbia University in New York, she returned to CU in May 1952 as associate professor and coordinator of the psychiatric nursing program
- She served as a mental health consultant for the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education
- She presented at numerous national and regional meetings and authored articles on psychiatric nursing that were referred to years later
 - She was a lifetime member of the American Nurses Association
- Her 'numerous theoretical contributions to nursing literature are professionally recognized classic publications'
