Ruth M. Harboe MSN, RN

- She received a BS in Nursing from Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh in 1945 and an MSN from CU in 1967.
- Her primary focus was the education of nursing students. She taught classes in six institutions, including the Community College of Denver, the University of Northern Colorado, Metro State College and CU.
- She was a member of ANA and CNA for more than 40 years, serving as president of DNA 20 from 1970-72. She was Region 1 Director and Board member from 1981 to 1983. She held several offices in Sigma Theta Tau, including president, 1979-80
- She held offices in the Colorado Cancer Society and received two honorary awards
- She was active in Friends of Nursing, working diligently to solicit money for nursing scholarships
- Her professionalism and dedication has positively affected the nursing practice
