Julia Ray Work, RN

- In 1913, she graduated from Beth-El Training School. Her long and dedicated nursing career focused on the families and children of Colorado Springs
- She was a school nurse with the Visiting Nurses Association and a city-county public health nursing. During World War I, she proudly served in England with the Red Cross Army Nurse Corps
- She was an early member of the Colorado Nurses Association and maintained this commitment for life. Her dedicated membership in District 3 in Colorado Springs led her to serve as president and, for many years, as secretariat and historian of the association
- She retired in 1964 after spending 51 years in active nursing
- Her memory and spirit 'lives on in the lives of many nurses from Colorado Springs, who knew her as their inspiration, mentor, nurse and guide'
